We provided a very detailed brief to the architects to ensure we maximised the site potential, without breaking any of the numerous mandatory rules within the highly restrictive Inner North Precinct Code. We were successful in advocating for our interpretation to be accepted in our dealings with the City Renewal Authority (CRA), the National Capital Authority (NCA) and the local Planning Authority (EPSDD) and Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS).
